

At Julia's House we constantly strive to improve our service to the community and we rely almost entirely on the generosity of the public to continue our work. Your gift, however large or small, will

- £5** could buy a set of fibre optic torches, great for sensory play
- £25** could pay for a 3-D Tactile Awareness Game - excellent for visual and tactile perception, language skills, memory and reasoning
- £60** covers the average cost of a care session in a family home
- £100** pays for a carer to support a child for one day
- £150** could pay for a vibrating musical light, providing visual, tactile and auditory stimulation
- £250** could buy a glow show, designed for powerful one-to-one or group interactive play
- £500** covers the cost of providing a morning's care for 8 children at the hospice

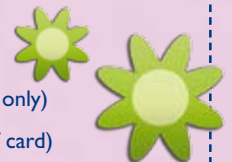
