

Terms and conditions of entry – Bournemouth Marathon Festival 2019

These terms and conditions apply to all people participating in The Bournemouth Marathon Festival for Julia's House, the Dorset and Wiltshire Children's Hospices, which is organised and operated by GSI Events. By taking a charity place for Julia's House in The Bournemouth Marathon Festival, each participant agrees to these terms and conditions.

Terms and conditions

1. You are signing up to participate in the Bournemouth Marathon Festival for Julia's House, the Dorset and Wiltshire Children's Hospices for which Julia's House will be covering the full cost of your entry. By signing up you are committing to raise the minimum sponsorship. 80% of the minimum sponsorship must be received no later than Friday 20th September 2019. The remaining 20% must be received by Thursday 31st October 2019.

Minimum sponsorship targets:

Full marathon	£500
Half marathon	£300
10k	£100
5k and Junior 5k	£50
Junior races	£30

2. I understand that if I do not raise 80% of the minimum sponsorship target by Friday 20th September 2019, Julia's House reserve the right to cancel my place in the Bournemouth Marathon Festival.
3. If you wish to cancel, you must inform us at least 24 hours before the event. If you do not inform us and have not met your sponsorship target, we will ask you to cover the full cost of you entry.
4. Participants are fully responsible for their actions while taking part in the Bournemouth Marathon Festival. We do not accept responsibility for the actions of the participant, nor the consequences of such actions.
5. We ask all participants and their supporters to be respectful of local residents, to not make excessive noise and to use the litter and recycling facilities available.
6. The Bournemouth Marathon Festival is not a race, it is a non-competitive run.
7. We operate a no smoking policy at events. We ask participants and their supporters to refrain from smoking during the event.
8. Participants must be confident that they are physically and mentally capable of running the distance they have chosen. If they are at all unsure about this, they should seek medical advice from their GP before the event.

9. Participants must wear their race number for the duration of the event.
10. We will be photographing and filming throughout the day, and we may use footage or photographs of you, your family or your team in our publications, promotion and advertising.
11. In order to participate in the Bournemouth Marathon Festival you must complete the registration form on www.bournemouthmarathon.com.
12. The contact details you provide on registration will be used for the Bournemouth Marathon Festival correspondence.
13. We reserve the right to refuse participation to any individual without providing a reason and to cancel or postpone the event completely for all participants at any time.
14. I will use my best endeavours to raise money for Julia's House in connection with my participation in the Bournemouth Marathon Festival. Any fundraising I undertake in connection with the Bournemouth Marathon Festival will be for Julia's House, the Dorset and Wiltshire Children's Hospices.
15. I will immediately inform Julia's House if anything happens which puts my participation in doubt. If I cannot take part in the event and do not inform Julia's House in advance, I am liable to cover the costs that Julia's House has paid for my place.
16. The race number is personal to the Participant accepting the Terms and Conditions, and the Participant upon signing the Terms and Conditions agrees not to authorise or permit any third party to use their race number.
17. If you choose the minimum sponsorship option, HMRC regulations state that as a percentage of your fundraising contributes to the cost of this event we will be unable to claim Gift Aid on any sponsorship from a relative (i.e Husband, Mother, Grandfather, Sibling or even Uncle). Therefore can you please advise your relatives when donating via Just Giving not to select that they are eligible for Gift Aid.
