

## **Terms and conditions of entry – Mallorca Cycle Challenge 2019**

These terms and conditions apply to all people participating in the Mallorca Cycle Challenge, which is organised and operated by Slick Events on behalf of Julia's House, the Dorset and Wiltshire Children's Hospices. By taking part in the Mallorca Cycle Challenge, each participant agrees to these terms and conditions.

### Terms and conditions

1. Participants are fully responsible for their actions while taking part in the Mallorca Cycle Challenge. We do not accept responsibility for the actions of the participant, nor the consequences of such actions.
2. We ask all participants and their supporters to be respectful of local residents, to not make excessive noise and to use the litter and recycling facilities available.
3. The Mallorca Cycle Challenge is not a race, it is a non-competitive cycle.
4. We operate a no smoking policy at events. We ask participants and their supporters to refrain from smoking during the event.
5. Participants must be confident that they are physically and mentally capable of cycling the distance they have chosen. If they are at all unsure about this, they should seek medical advice from their GP before the event.
6. We will be photographing and filming throughout the event, and we may use footage or photographs of you, your family or your team in our publications, promotion and advertising.
7. In order to participate in the Mallorca Cycle Challenge, you must complete a registration form and pay the registration fee.
8. The contact details you provide on registration will be used for the Mallorca Cycle Challenge correspondence.
9. Your deposit is non-refundable. This is a contribution towards the administration costs of putting on the Mallorca Cycle Challenge and will be used to pay for your flight.
10. Anyone aged under 18 years must get permission to take part from their parent or guardian before registering. We ask that all under 18s ride with a responsible adult on the day. The minimum age for this event is 16.
11. We reserve the right to refuse participation to any individual without providing a reason and to cancel or postpone the event completely for all participants at any time.

12. By paying your deposit, you are committing to raising the minimum sponsorship of £1,499 (sponsorship-funded). 50% of the minimum sponsorship must be received by 3rd June 2019. The remaining 50% must be received no later than 1 week before departure. Failure to do so may mean non-participation in the challenge. All outstanding sponsorship must be sent to Julia's House within four weeks of completing the Challenge.
13. I will use my best endeavours to raise money for Julia's House in connection with my participation in the Mallorca Cycle Challenge. Any fundraising I undertake in connection with the Mallorca Cycle Challenge will be for Julia's House, the Dorset and Wiltshire Children's Hospices.
14. I will immediately inform Julia's House if anything happens which puts my participation in doubt.
15. We reserve the right to alter the route at any time without prior notice.
16. If you choose the minimum sponsorship option, HMRC regulations state that as a percentage of your fundraising contributes to the cost of this event we will be unable to claim Gift Aid on any sponsorship from a relative (i.e. Husband, Mother, Grandfather, Sibling or even Uncle). Therefore, can you please advise your relatives when donating via JustGiving not to select that they are eligible for Gift Aid.
